This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) entered on **1st of FEBRUARY 2024.**

By and Between

AND

DIVYA ENGINEERING WORKS - Hootagalli Industrial Area, Plot No. 31, Mysuru, Karnataka 570018 and represented by **Chief Operating Officer**

The purpose of this agreement is with reference to defining the areas of co-operation benefiting both the organizations & agreeing to offer a package of academic interface program consisting of the following areas:

1. Industry & Institution interaction to get an insight in to the requirement of industries and to develop relevant talents among the students and to mould them to meet tomorrow's challenges.
2. To provide Industrial Training and Internship to students to build confidence to have smooth transition from academic to working career.
3. Industrial visit to increase the knowledge level of students.
4. Arranging joint seminars from industrial professionals to share their knowledge with students & faculty members.
5. Organizing joint meetings of industrial professionals with faculty members to discuss on various topics & curriculum to incorporate requirements of present day industries.

6. To provide support for carrying out project work to the students and faculty members.
7. Identifying & organizing need based training to faculty members.
8. To support for organizing placement drives for students.
9. The resource persons of both the organizations will be utilized to conduct seminars / workshops / industry-institute interactions meet, for the benefit of students.
10. The area of expertise of faculty members from both the parties shall be used in setting up of Centers of Excellence (COE) and other such bodies and for mutual participation in their activities.
11. Both the organizations will utilize the available infrastructure facilities, especially COE's, to conduct skill enhancement training programs to make students industry ready.
12. The parties shall keep each other informed and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities of interaction for mutual benefit.
13. This agreement of MOU may be executed by both the parties each of which shall be deemed as original and together shall constitute one and the same document.
14. If any dispute arises, it shall be resolved mutually by both the parties. However, the decision of President & Chief Operating Officer of Divya Engineering Works and the Principal of Vidyavardhaka Polytechnic, Mysuru as agreed upon will be final & binding.
15. To give valuable inputs to the faculty on training methodology and customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario.
16. To carry out the joint research activities in the fields of engineering, software development, manufacturing activities.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The parties shall take all necessary steps to protect the confidentiality of such materials or information either party shall use the confidential information of the party for the purpose other than those contemplated.
2. The parties would mutually decide & agree to fix the fees to be collected from each candidate against receipt issued by Divya Engineering Works depending upon the training program. Award joint certification as may be appropriate to those who successfully complete the training programs.
3. Press note, public announcements or any other disclosure concerning this agreement shall be made at relevant platforms, only after mutual consent.

VALIDITY

This agreement of co-operation is valid for duration of three years (3 years) with effect from the date of signing of the agreement of co-operation and can be renewed by mutual consent thereafter. Either party can cancel or terminate this agreement unilaterally without assigning any reason by giving an advance notice of 30 days to the other party.

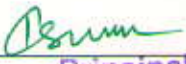

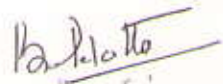

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 30.01.2024 between Karnataka German Technical Training Institute (KGT TI), an institute under Society for Karnataka German Multi Skill Development Centre (KGMSDC), established by Government of Karnataka, under funding from Government of India & Government of Karnataka, and having Technical Collaboration with German International Services (GIZ-IS), having its office at CoE Building, Bannerughatta Road, Behind Women's ITI, Kaushalya Bhavan Campus, Dairy Circle, Bengaluru 560029, India (hereinafter referred to as KGT TI), represented by its Director on the one part.

AND

Vidyavardhaka polytechnic is popularly known as VVP, is one of the most prestigious polytechnic in Karnataka, established in 2005, VVP has grown in leaps and bounds. Vidyavardhaka polytechnic is affiliated to the Department of Technical Education (DTE), Bangalore and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi.

This MoU is made for imparting skill development training under different training programs organized by KGT TI With Vidyavardhaka Polytechnic for their students and Staff

In this connection, the following points are agreed upon:

1. Objective:

The overall objective of the KGT TI is to provide skill development, advanced technology hands-on-Training and to enhance employment opportunities. To achieve this objective, the VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC will mobilize its students/ participants to undergo skill-development training to make them industry ready/Fit.

2. Recitals:

- a. KGT TI is an organization providing technical skill training and consultancy services in advanced technology areas to students, jobseekers, school dropouts, and unemployed youth and industry personnel.
- b. VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC is an institution engaged in imparting Technical Education to develop professional and technical skills and prepare the students /Employees for immediate employment and provide them with a solid foundation for further education.

c. The purpose of this agreement is with reference to defining the areas of co-operation benefiting both VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC and KGTTI.

This agreement witnesses as follows:

Areas of co-operation

3. Scope of Agreement:

KGTTI:

- KGTTI to liaison with VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC for providing advanced technical skill training to the students or participants mobilized by VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC.
- KGTTI will provide training on the specified list of Courses (See Annexure - I) to different category of students referred by VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC.
- KGTTI will, unless otherwise stated utilize its premises, subject experts, software and training kits / equipment for conducting training.

VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC:

- To promote courses run by KGTTI, VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC will mobilize its students/Participants to undergo training at KGTTI.
- Subject to mutual convenience, VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC will utilize the services of the faculty of KGTTI to render specialized domain intervention and conduct technical sessions in order to promote the KGTTI activities and motivate the students.
- VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC shall initiate students' meet and other business promotional activities to promote the training activities of KGTTI. KGTTI shall provide technical support, presentation and promotional materials for such events.

4. Training Support & Methodology:

The training shall be conducted at KGTTI premises or at the premises of the VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC if the KGTTI satisfies itself on the adequacy of the infrastructure to conduct such training programs.

- Subject to availability of adequate infrastructure, KGTTI can conduct sandwich courses wherein partial training can be conducted at VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC premises or any other mutually agreed place with other associated activities conducted at KGTTI.
- KGTTI shall provide all support needed for imparting the necessary training to the students mobilized by VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC.

- Each Training program of specified duration will be carried out on mutually agreed terms.
- KGTTI will issue the Certificates to the students after successful completion of the training program. Also, since KGTTI is an authorized Local Academy for Cisco, eligible students trained in Cisco authorized courses would get certificates from CISCO along with a discount voucher (62.3%) for the Global Certification Examination (This is subject to fulfilling the Cisco norms)

5. General Agreements:

- Both the parties agree that no action / failure on either part, to act relating to the above proposal, will give rise to / serve as the basis for any claim, obligation or liability on either side.
- Both the parties can issue press release, make public announcement, or other such disclosure related to this Agreement without the other party's prior consent as long as it does not affect the aim, objective, ethical values and reputation of the respective Institutions.
- This Agreement may be amended with the prior written consent of both the parties.
- Subject to availability of infrastructure and other facilities at KGTTI, students of VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC and undergoing training at KGTTI can take up appropriate projects which may be required as part of Academic requirement at VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC. If required, such projects can be carried out in co-ordination with the associated faculty from VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC.
- This agreement is valid from 30.01.2024 to 29.01.2026.
- Either party can cancel or terminate this Agreement by giving an advance notice of three (3) months to the other with proper justification for such act.

6. Course Deliverables:

The list of courses offered, eligibility criteria and fee structure is appended at Annexure-I.

- KGTTI will follow its standard methodologies related to conduct, student attendance, globally accepted quality norms, student feedback, internal assessments, examination, evaluation and certification, smooth & effective delivery of course content and competence building of the trainee student.
- The training shall be conducted at KGTTI premises or at the premises of the VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC if the KGTTI satisfies itself on the adequacy of the infrastructure to conduct such training programs.

- Subject to availability of adequate infrastructure, KGTTI can conduct sandwich courses wherein partial training can be conducted at VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC premises or any other mutually agreed place with other associated activities conducted at KGTTI. The minimum & maximum student batch size for commencing a batch will be decided
- on mutually agreed numbers and it is as per the available seating capacity at KGTTI
- The listed courses can vary from time to time and courses shall be added / deleted based on mutual convenience, in discussion by both the parties.
- The technical support in terms of presentations and publicity material shall be provided by KGTTI.

Note :

- The duration of training course per day is flexible to suit the requirements of the Institution / Students/Participants. This will be in mutual consultation between KGTTI and VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC.
- Also, KGTTI has an open mind to conduct week-end courses i.e., on Saturday and Sunday provided if full batch size of students in any of the streams that it would like to have the training.

7. Course Fee and mode of payment:

- The course fee at present is as reflected in Annexure – I. for regular programs
- If any changes in course fee in future will be communicated to participants.
- For tailor made program course fee will be of Rs.350 per student per day subject to minimum of 20 students in a batch. Duration of the program will be of 3- 5 days.
- KGTTI offers a discount of 20% on the listed course fee to the students of VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC in minimum number of participants as per the batch size.
- KGTTI shall issue an appropriate invoice / receipt by collecting fees from the participants.
- The students will have to pay the course fee at the time of admission either through cash/cheque to KGTTI.
- For SC/ST students course fee is exempted.

Note: All payments shall be made in favour of the Director, KGTTI - MYSURU.

- VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC fully understands that the fees charged is a fair estimate of the expenditure incurred by KGTTI for utilizing the infrastructure, designing & developing the program content, acquiring the necessary principal licenses, hardware, providing the course material and for arranging lectures by certified experts in the current technologies including assistance in extending placement to eligible students trained in KGTTI.
- KGTTI shall prepare a consolidated list of students mobilized/referred by VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC and enrolled to the different courses and make available a copy of the same to VIDYAVARDHAKA POLYTECHNIC as and when the process of admission for the respective courses are completed.

8. Notices:

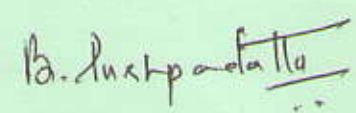

AND WHEREAS,

Government Tool Room & Training Centre (GTTC) was established in 1972 at Bangalore with the participation of the Karnataka State Government, in collaboration with the Government of Denmark under the Bilateral Development Co-operation Agreement. GTTC is an autonomous society and recognized as Scientific and Research Organization by the Government of India. Govt. Tool Room and Training Centre (GTTC) is serving industries in the field of precision tooling, Defense & Aerospace sectors and providing well trained craftsmen in the area of Tooling & Precision Manufacturing. AND WHEREAS **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** and said institution (PESITM) have in principle accepted the terms and conditions mutually agreed upon by and between them.

AND WHEREAS the parties hereto are desirous of recording the said terms and conditions in the manner herein after appearing:

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING **WITNESSES** AND IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERE TO AS UNDER; -

Permission:

Government Tool Room & Training Centre and said institution (VVP) shall establish collaborations for the purpose of:

- a) Carrying out internship programmes for enhancing the knowledge and skills of students.
- b) Carrying out project works to promote overall development of students and make them industry ready.
- c) Arranging industrial visit to students, to orient them to industrial environment and to interact with professionals.
- d) Conducting seminar by resource person from the said institution to enhance the knowledge of faculties and students.
- e) The minimum of 100 Candidates/ year has to be trained under **Centre of Excellence (COE)** & other short term courses at GT&TC Mysuru.

Conduct of various programs, events etc.

- a) The said courses / programs / events called by any name shall be conducted by said institution and **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** in collaboration and shall be overseen by a standing committee consisting of two representatives each of company and institution.
- b) The venue of the said courses, programs, events called by any name shall be decided and conducted by mutual understanding of both the parties.
- c) The content and delivery of the course / program shall be designed by mutual understanding by both the parties.
- d) There are no financial commitments from either side.

Goodwill:

The **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** and said institution (VVP) both shall Endeavour to maintain, promote and improve the goodwill and image of both the organizations.

Tenure:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall continue to be in operation for a period of three years commencing from the date of signing this MOU. Upon the expiry of this Memorandum of Understanding and/or six months prior thereto, both parties are entitled to the renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding for a future period of three years by issuing a written notice to the other to that effect. Upon the extension notice being issued to either party and upon acceptance thereof, this Memorandum of Understanding may be continued beyond the period of three years on the terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon between the **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** and said institution.

Termination

1. If there is a breach of any of the conditions by either party, then Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated with one-month prior notice by either party without affecting the students or participants of larger interest.

On Termination:

On termination of this Memorandum of Understanding:

- a) No joint, collaborative programmes, called by any name shall be undertaken by either of the institutes thereafter.
- b) Neither **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** nor the said institution (VVP) shall be responsible for any loss or damage which may be caused because of destruction of any materials, cancellation of any programmes or in any other manner or on account of termination of the Memorandum of Understanding.
- c) Parties hereto agree to settle outstanding dues if any.
- d) Neither **Government Tool Room & Training Centre** nor the said institution (VVP) shall have any right or title or interest in the name and goodwill of the other party.
- e) None of the parties shall, after termination of the Memorandum of Understanding claim, advertise or suggest any association with another party.
- f) Legitimate interests of students, participants will be protected, within one year of discontinuation of Memorandum of Understanding as applicable.

Third party Agencies:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall not create any mutual agency between the Parties to this Memorandum of Understanding. Neither party shall be authorized to Make any commitment to any third party with respect to this Memorandum of Understanding.

Force Majeure:

Neither party to the Memorandum of Understanding shall be liable to the other party for any delay or failure on its part to performing any of its obligations under this Memorandum of Understanding resulting from any cause beyond its reasonable control, including, but not limited to strikes, riots, civil commotion or other concerned action of workmen, material, shortage, fire, flood, explosions, acts of God, acts of state, war, enemy action or terrorist action.

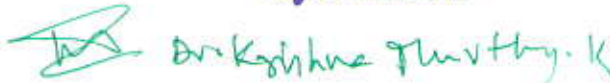

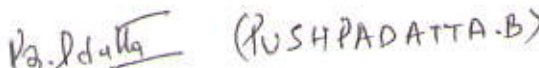

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- 4 Arranging joint seminars from Industrial professionals to share their knowledge with students & faculty members.
- 5 Organizing Joint meetings of Industrial professionals with faculty members to discuss on various topics & Curriculum to incorporate requirements of present day industries.
- 6 To provide support for carrying out project work to the students and faculty members.
- 7 Identify & organizing need based training to faculty members.
- 8 To support for organizing placements drive for students.



- 9 The resource person of both the organizations will be utilized to conduct seminars/ workshops/industry-institute interactions meet, for the benefit of students.
- 10 The area of expertise of faculty members from both the parties shall be used in setting up of Centers of Excellence (COE) and other such bodies and for mutual participation of their activities.
- 11 Both the organizations will utilize the available infrastructure facilities, especially COE's to conduct skill enhancement training programs to make students industry ready.
- 12 The parties shall keep each other informed and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities of interaction for mutual benefit.
- 13 This agreement of MOU may be executed by both the parties each of which shall be deemed as original and together shall constitute one and the same document.
- 14 If any dispute arises, it shall be resolved mutually by both the parties. However, the decision of Managing Director of SSS Mysuru and the Principal of Government CPC Polytechnic as agreed upon will be final & binding.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By signing this MOU, Vidyavardhaka Polytechnic has no obligation to make any payment to SSS Mysuru or vice versa.
2. There shall not be any issues binding legally and financially whatsoever, between the Vidyavardhaka Polytechnic and SSS Mysuru.
3. The parties shall take all necessary steps to protect the confidentiality of such materials or information either party shall use the confidential information of the party for the purpose other than those contemplated.
4. The parties would mutually decide & agree to fix the fees to be collected from each candidate again receipt issued by SSS Mysuru depending upon



the training program. Award joint certification as may be appropriate to those who successfully complete the training programs.

5. Press note, public announcements or any other disclosure concerning this agreement shall be made at relevant platforms, only after mutual consent.

VALIDITY

This agreement of co-operation is valid for duration of Three Years (3 Years) with effect from the date of signing of the agreement of co-operation and can be renewed by mutual consent thereafter. Either party can cancel or terminate this agreement unilaterally without assigning any reason by giving an advance notice of 30 days to the other party.
